

The event will take place on Sunday, March 10, at 4:00 p.m. in the Wilder Center at Rome First UMC. There will be signs posted to make the entrance



easy to find. People may park in the Wilder Center lot and the two lots behind it.

The biggest thing right now is for people to register to serve. The number of packing stations they set up will be based on the number of volunteers who have registered. When people register, they can select what parts of the event they'd like to help with: set-up, food packing, and/or clean up. They will need people for all parts, so people are welcome to sign up for any and all sections.
